RULES, REGULATIONS AND INFORMATION

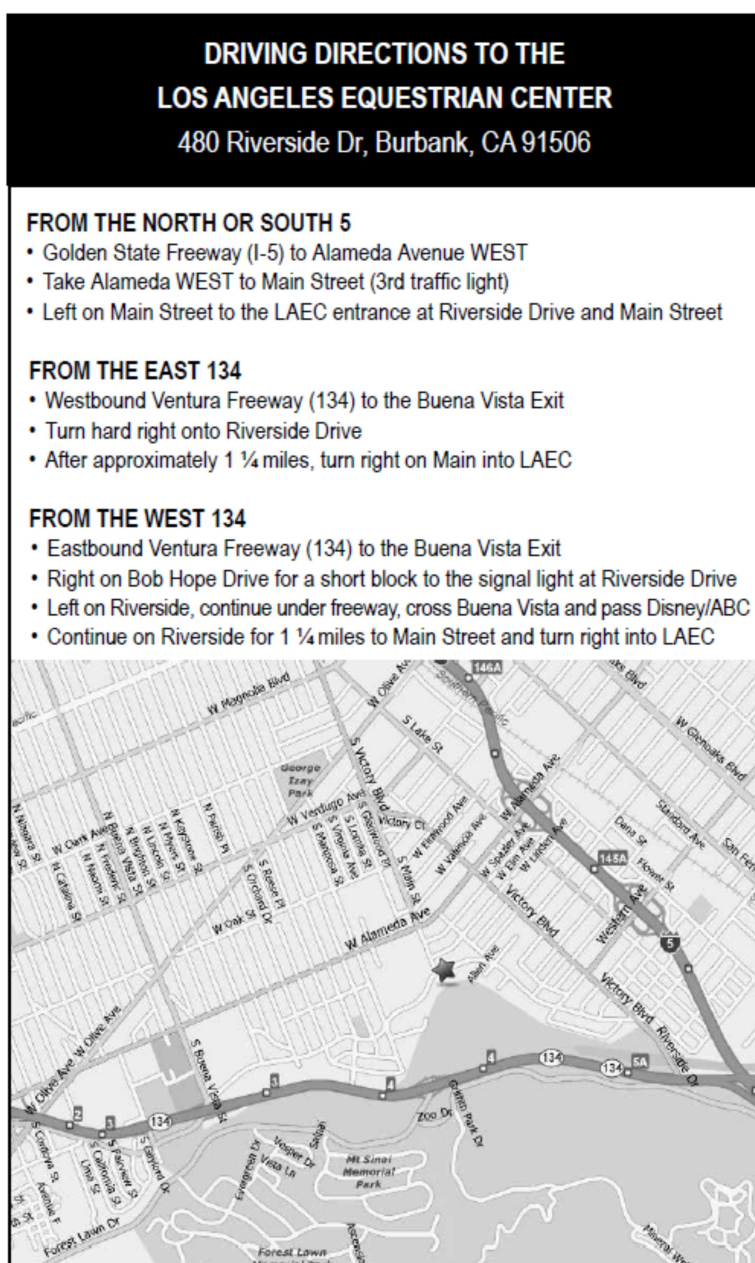
General Information: Los Angeles Equestrian Center
480 Riverside Drive
Burbank, CA 91506

The following Rules and Regulations are to be observed by all Event Licensees, all Los Angeles Equestrian Center visitors and facility users, and shall be enforced by ASM, City management and/or security personnel.

1. Golf carts shall be operated only by an individual possessing a valid driver's license, and be at least 16 years of age. Golf cart owners, vendors, lessees, or suppliers shall be responsible for the safe operation of all carts.
2. Only qualified ASM employees may use ASM equipment.
3. ASM shall not be liable for lost, stolen, or damaged personal property. Unclaimed perishable property shall be disposed of. Other personal property left or found at the CENTER will be held in a lost and found program, if unclaimed after (90) days, property shall become the sole property of ASM and donated to a local Burbank charity.
4. Any EVENT accident when the **EVENT medic** responds or outside medical services are called, regardless of its nature shall be immediately reported to ASM management.
5. Sale and/or **distribution of food and beverage** on the CENTER are not permitted without the written consent of ASM.
6. Any unauthorized use of the CENTER and/or its utilities is prohibited.
7. **Alcoholic beverages are not permitted on the CENTER unless provided by ASM Global or its contracted vendors.**
8. Open cooking or campfires are prohibited unless specifically approved in writing by ASM.
9. Disposal of trash or solid waste materials is allowed in designated areas or receptacles only.
10. Federal and City laws and regulations may prohibit washing of trailers, RVs, and vehicles on property without permits and/or permission. Any unauthorized use is not permitted.
11. Firearms are not permitted unless specifically approved by City, State or Federal authority.
12. Fireworks or explosives may not be brought onto property unless specifically approved in writing by ASM.
13. ASM discourages visitors from bringing dogs and pets to the CENTER. Dogs and other pets must be on a leash at all times and may not be allowed in seating areas of arenas, or in food and beverage areas prohibited by any applicable regulations. **It is the responsibility of LICENSEE to ensure that this policy is enforced within the portions of the CENTER rented for the EVENT.**
14. Smoking is prohibited on the ASM grounds. ASM is part of the City of Los Angeles park system and the City of Los Angeles prohibits smoking in all parks, except designated smoking areas.
15. Motor vehicles are prohibited within stable facilities except to load/unload horses, tack, feed, unless authorized in writing by ASM management.
16. Overnight parking is not allowed, except in an RV or other specifically designated areas, unless authorized in

writing by ASM management. **Horse trailers parked at the CENTER for the LICENSEE's EVENT are exempt.**

17. The traffic, speed limit and parking signs are to be observed at all times.
18. Designated fire lanes are to be kept clear at all times. Vehicles in unauthorized areas may be towed at the owner's expense. Unauthorized vehicles parked at ASM overnight or in unauthorized locations are subject to towing at the owner's expense.
19. **ASM visitors and facility users may not post or exhibit any printed material such as posters, signs or advertisements unless authorized in writing by ASM management and LICENSEE for areas under contract to LICENSEE.**
20. ASM reserves the right to evict from the property anyone displaying inappropriate behavior, drunkenness, disobeying the Rules and Regulation, or creating excessive noise or disturbances.
21. Facility users and visitors must comply with all environmental laws, rules, and regulations.
22. When not associated with an event or horse show, facility users and RV guests shall register with ASM and sign a Liability Release Agreement prior to utilizing the CENTER's facility.

SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. *Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF rule book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.*
2. **Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes**
3. The Rated Sections of this Competition are official USEF point competitions for the USEF Federation and USEF/ZONE 10 Horse of the Year Awards Program.
4. The Horse Show Executive Committee reserves the right to interpret all questions and conditions in regard to, or arising out of, or incident to, the show without claims for damages or recourse of any kind. Any questions not covered in these rules and regulations shall be decided by the Horse Show Executive Committee, their decision is final. The Horse Show Executive Committee to include the President and Vice President of the California Saddle Horse Breeders Association, Horse Show Manager, Horse Show Secretary and an Attorney.
5. **HACKNEY PONIES** must be registered with the American Hackney Horse Society and/or the Canadian Hackney Society. They must be entered in their full registered names, with registration numbers and under the name of the owner(s) of record with the AHHS or CHS. A copy of the registration papers, showing proof of ownership must be submitted with the entry form. Ponies may not be shown in Harness or Roadster Pony classes unless the owner possesses a current measurement card or valid measurement form issued by the USEF. All Open Roadster Ponies must be re-measured and issued new measurement cards prior to competing in recognized competitions for the year 2006 and beyond (effective 3/1/04). Please send Copies with your entry form if you have been re-measured since 2006. Exhibitors, trainers and owners must be a member of the USEF or pay a non-member fee. Owners and trainers must be members of AHHS. **Copies of current membership cards are required.**
6. **AMERICAN SADDLEBRED HORSES** must be registered with the American Saddlebred Registry or the Canadian Livestock Records Corporation. They must be entered in their full registered names with registration numbers and under the names of the owner(s) of record. A copy of the registration papers showing recorded ownership or Certificate of Eligibility to show must be submitted with entry form at the time of making entry or presented to competition office before competition number will be released. Owners, trainers, riders, drivers and handlers must be current competing members in good standing with the American Saddlebred Horse & Breeders Association or ASHA of Canada. **Copies of current membership cards are required.**
7. **MORGAN HORSES** shown in this division must be registered with the American Morgan Horse Association, Inc., or an organization having registry reciprocity, (Canadian Morgan Horse Association, British Morgan Horse Society, Swedish Morgan Horse Society). Horses must be entered under their full registered name and under the names of the owner(s) or lessee of record. Stripping for conformation is not required. Exhibitors, trainers and owners must be a member of the USEF or pay a non-member fee. Exhibitors, trainers and owners must be members of AMHA, or an organization having registry reciprocity, or pay a \$45 non-member fee to participate. **Copies of current membership cards and horse registration papers showing current ownership are required.**
8. **Andalusian Horses**
85. All entries are accepted with the understanding that the California Saddle Horse Futurity Horse Show, the Los Angeles Equestrian Center will not be held responsible for any loss, damage or injury to any horse exhibited or any article of any kind. All horses shall be under the control and direction of the Show Committee but solely at the risk of the exhibitor, who will be responsible for any loss, damage or injury to any person, animal or property occasioned to him, his agents or employees, or by any animal owned or exhibited by him, and shall indemnify the California Saddle Horse Futurity Horse Show, Los Angeles Equestrian Center against any and all loss, damage and liability thus occasioned including but not limited to any and all legal costs, including attorney fees, which may be incurred as a result thereof. The submitting of an entry form shall constitute an acceptance by each person of the provisions herein set forth.
9. All owners and exhibitors will be held responsible for any damage incurred by them or their agents to barns or Los Angeles Equestrian Center properties and will be billed accordingly.
10. The California Saddle Horse Futurity Horse Show reserves the right to refuse or accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, and cancel award prizes, without claim for damages.
11. **The California Saddle Horse Futurity Horse Show reserves the right to cancel and/or combine classes with insufficient entries, and will combine classes specifically as prescribed in the class specifications.**

12. The California Saddle Horse Futurity Horse Show reserves the privilege of substituting or changing judges if it becomes necessary. The judges' decisions in the show ring are their own responsibility and the Show Committee accepts no responsibility for these decisions.
13. Entries will be considered acceptable if they are:
 - 1) Properly signed, by the owner, trainer and rider, and, in the case of a minor, signed by a parent or guardian.
 - 2) Made on an entry blank provided by the Show.
 - 3) Showing correct mailing address of owner.
 - 4) ACCOMPANIED BY A MINIMUM PAYMENT THAT COVERS THE STALLS AND HORSE FEES. PAYMENT MAY BE MADE BY CHECK OR CREDIT CARD AUTHORIZATION. (Visa, Master Card, Discover - 4% fee)
 - 5) ACCOMPANIED BY CURRENT REGISTRATION PAPERS AND COPIES OF ALL USEF MEMBERSHIP AND ALL BREED MEMBERSHIP CARDS, AS APPLICABLE.
14. Entries close October 17, 2026. **Do not mail after this date.** Post Entries may be accepted with penalty at the show office. **Entries** may also be entered online at: www.HorseShowsOnline.com Stall Reservations must be made by the closing of entries, October 17th. Stalls may be reserved by calling or texting Ron Hood at (831) 524-5248 or email at rhood722@gmail.com **ENTRY FORM FOR STALLS ONLY MAY BE MAILED TO SHOW MANAGER WITH PAYMENT.**
15. **SAFE SPORT REMINDER:** All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. More information about these can be found at www.usef.org.
16. Stabling. Stalls will not be available until 8:00 a.m. TUESDAY, OCTOBER 27th. Stalls must be vacated by 10:00 a.m., Sunday, November 1st. Stalls have solid top and bottom doors.
17. Early Arrival: Anyone arriving earlier than 8:00 AM, Tuesday, October 27th, MUST contact the Show Manager to make arrangements. Early arrivals will be required to pay a fee of \$40 per day per STALL.
18. Cancellation or Substitution of Entries. Exhibitors canceling their entries for any reason other than illness of horse or rider after the official entry closing date shall forfeit entry and stall fees. In case of illness, a Veterinarian or Doctor Certificate is required before close of show, whereby entry fee and stall fee will be refunded, less a \$25.00 office fee. Where exhibitors or trainers wish to make a change in entries in any class, they are required to follow the procedure of scratching the existing entry and making a new entry with the Show Secretary's office. Such changes shall be treated as post entries and charged the post entry fee. In the event of the sale or injury to a horse (Veterinarian's Certificate required), exhibitors may post enter another horse in the same class at the rate of \$5.00 per class.
19. Changes. Care should be taken to enter animal in its proper class. Sex and age of horses must be correctly stated, as well as the correct date of birth of Junior riders. Exhibitors are responsible for their errors and those of their agents in making out entry blanks. Any changes will be charged for at the rate of \$10 per class. In all classes, the description on the entry blank must fully identify horses. The word "entry" will not be accepted.
20. Scratches and Rider Changes. All scratches and rider changes MUST be made in the Horse Show Office **no later than 2 hours prior to start** of Performance.
21. Championship Entries. To be eligible, horses must qualify in class as noted in list of classes. No Post Entry Fee will be charged on any Championship/Stake Class.
22. USEF Amateur Certification. Every person who has reached his 18th birthday and competes in classes for amateurs under USEF rules must possess current amateur certification issued by the Federation. This certification must be available for inspection or the competitor must have lodged with the Show Secretary, at least one hour prior to such class, an application for such certification provided by the Federation.
23. RV Facilities. Overnight facilities are available at LAEC Contact Ron Hood @ 831-524-5248 for \$70 per night.
24. Hay, grain and additional bedding will be available on the grounds at reasonable and competitive prices and may be ordered through the show office.
25. Food and beverages will be available during horse show performances.
26. QUESTIONS, DISPUTES and PROTESTS. All protests and questions not covered by these rules shall be decided and interpreted by the Competition Committee, whose decision shall be final. Disputes should be presented to the Show Manager prior to filing a formal protest under the provisions of the USEF Rule GR 603.

27. There will be a penalty of \$50.00 if a check is refused by the bank for any reason. No checks will be processed through the bank a second time, and must be covered by a money order, cashier's check or cash, in addition to the penalty.
28. No competition numbers will be released by the Show Office until all entry forms are complete, all waivers are signed, all necessary registration papers and measurement cards have been seen, and payment in full has been received by the Show Office. A SIGNED OPEN CHECK, OR CREDIT CARD MUST BE LEFT WITH THE SHOW OFFICE FOR FEES INCURRED DURING THE SHOW.
29. Prize money will be paid by check and mailed within 30 days.
30. Arena Footing is clay and sand and is properly maintained to the specifications of the Saddlebred Division. Stalls are 10' by 10'. Arena is 150' by 300'
31. **MOTORIZED VEHICLES** - Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. ***The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation.*** Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to Segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

Select Series Regional Championship

The Select Series is a program from the ASHBA designed to promote showing Saddlebreds at all levels of competition. To be eligible, horses must have been declared to ASHBA and have shown in at least one other Select Series show in their division in Region 1 or 2 during this show year. Any horses that have competed at the World Championship Horse show in non-equitation divisions are not eligible. Regional Championship classes will be run concurrently with the Show class of the same name, horses will be judged and placed in the Show class, then placed in the Select Series division. Online Horse Show Entry

This year, in addition to mailing entries, you can also enter online at www.HorseShowsOnline.com

There is no fee to enter online and information can be saved and used at other horse shows. Once on their website, click on tab – “Member Services” and either login, or, create a new account.

Add your personal information at the ‘People’ tab. Also add riders and trainers at your ‘People’ tab – you will need this when entering a show. Add your horse information at the ‘Horse’ tab – including association numbers.

Select ‘Show Entries’ tab and then ‘Enter A Show’ tab. Scroll down to CA Futurity Horse Show with a start date of October 29, 2026. Select this show and then click on ‘Start a new Entry’ tab.

The online entry wizard will guide you through the steps to complete the entry form. The basic steps in the wizard are:

- Select the horse, people and riders for your entry
- Scroll through the divisions and select the classes each rider is entered in – click on small square on far right
- At next step, review what appropriate fees are associated with your entry – e.g. how many stalls and if non-member fees
- If the information is correct – click on ‘checkout’ tab and you will be prompted to enter credit card information. Ignore credit card requirement – will collect at show check-in.

Rules for the Academy Division

1. Horses are NOT judged. Horses in the Academy classes MUST be lesson horses used regularly in a professionally operated academy program. These horses must display the characteristics of such.
2. All Academy classes are to be judged on the ability of the RIDER to control and show his/her horse to the best advantage.
3. **Academy Equitation** classes are judged on BASIC equitation skills with correct diagonals and leads.
4. **Academy Showmanship** classes should be judged on the rider's horsemanship abilities. The horse is NOT to be judged. It should be judged on the rider's ability to control and show his/her horse. Promptness in finding the correct diagonals and canter leads are important, as well as the rider's command of the horse. For example: speed, placement in the ring and collectiveness.
5. Headers are allowed if class is split to include a 10 & Under Equitation and Showmanship classes.

Riders

1. No full riding suits. Helmets are required. Jackets are not allowed.
2. Riders must be participating in a professionally operated lesson program and show on lesson horses.
3. A rider may own his/her horse as long as the horse is REGULARLY used in the lesson program.
4. A rider may not cross enter between the Academy and show division at this show.
5. Once a rider has shown in a walk/trot/canter class at this or any horse show, they may not enter a walk/trot-only class.

Horses

1. Horses in the Academy classes MUST be lesson horses regularly used in a professionally operated lesson program. Horses are not to be judged.
2. Horses MUST be flat/keg shod. Corrective shoeing will be allowed WITHOUT excessive pads. Soundness is not to be considered.
3. Horses may be shown in snaffles and martingales or full bridles.
4. Flat cutback English type saddles are to be used.
5. Academy horses may cross enter in the show division at this show. Show horses (horses not used regularly in a professional lesson program and shown regularly in show performance or equitation classes) may NOT cross enter in the Academy division.
6. Hoof blacking is optional. Braiding is not allowed.

Horses should be owned or leased by the instructor or riding program. Horses in training will not be allowed. No tail sets allowed. Chains or other action devices must not be used on the show grounds.
